These quiet time print outs are resources that I have made so that you can help your children learn how to study God's Word. These are not all encompassing, but rather a beginning point. Just like a child must learn the alphabet before reading a novel, these tools are meant to be building blocks that will help your child see that they can take a verse, or passage, and study what it means and how it applies to their life.


IMPORTANT: The goal is to NOT change the meaning of God's Word. When we are replacing one word with another please make sure your child understands, we are simply using synonyms. We want to make sure the words have the very same meaning. The goal is to help us understand the verse better. For example, I might switch "merciful" with "compassionate", but they have the same meaning.

www.blueletterbible.com or the Blue Letter Bible app are really incredible resources that can help when you aren't sure what a word means. I will include a guide to using the app. You can also use a thesaurus, just be careful to choose words that are true to the original meaning of the verse.
